

# INTERSESSION CLOSING

## SOUTHWEST RESIDENTS:

Residence Halls will close for Intercession on WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 22, 1976 AT 6:00 P.M. The dorms will be secured until spring semester opening on SUNDAY, JANUARY 23, 1977 AT NOON.

Please take with you all personal possessions that you will need during the Intercession period. Residents will not be allowed in the dorms between the above closing and opening dates. At a minimum, you are encouraged to take with you all valuables. The University does not carry insurance which will compensate students for losses due to fire, theft, water damage, etc.

Please be advised that rooms will be checked during security sweeps which will be conducted on an on-going basis during Intercession by Public Safety and Residential Resource Management personnel, for the purpose of locating unauthorized inhabitants, University property (elevator parts, etc.) and to identify health and safety hazards (University of Massachusetts/Amherst Regulations and Policies, Provisions for Inspections). Storage of motorcycles or other internal combustion engines within residence halls is in violation of Health and Safety Regulations. Any motorcycles located during security sweeps will be removed and stored and their owners billed for related charges and fees.

Rooms that contain personal property will not be cleaned during Intercession.

## Before you leave:

1. Close and lock windows
2. Turn off lights
3. Dispose of food, defrost and unplug refrigerators
4. Unplug other appliances and electrical equipment
5. Extinguish candles
6. Lock your door
7. If you are changing rooms next semester, turn in your room keys and complete an inventory check-out form.

You are reminded that the presence of pets in Residence Halls is in violation of health regulations. The policy will continue to be strictly enforced (University of Massachusetts/Amherst Regulations and Policies, Provisions for Live Animals/Pets).
